



## FAQ for Alcohol Ordinance Changes

Q: When do the new alcohol ordinance changes go into effect?

A: December 7, 2021

### Sec. 6-70 Permit holders of licensees—Applications, issuance, and denials

Q: Is a non-compensated employee or independent contractor required to have a server permit?

A: YES, all employees and independent contractors, whether compensated or non-compensated, who sell and/or serve or who are authorized or requested or may be requested by the licensee to sell and/or serve alcoholic beverages are required to have a server permit.

### Sec. 6-87 Employment and entry upon the premises

Q: Are server permits required for all employees prior to working a license establishment?

A: Yes, all employees and independent contractors, whether compensated or non-compensated, are required to obtain and possess a server permit prior to working in the licensed establishment.

### Sec. 6-93 Hours of Operation

Q: Is the sale of alcoholic beverages for off premise consumption permissible after 11:29am on Sunday?

A: Yes, the sale of alcoholic beverages by the package is permissible between the hours of 11:30am to 11:30pm on Sunday.

Q: Can I sell alcoholic beverages for on premise consumption after 1:59am?

A: No, the licensee **SHALL NOT** engage in the sale of any alcoholic beverages by the drink for on-premises consumption between the hours of 2:00am and 8:00am Monday through Friday.

Q: Can I sell alcoholic beverages for on premise consumption after 1:59am on Sunday?

A: No, the licensee **SHALL NOT** engage in the sale of any alcoholic beverages by the drink for on-premises consumption between the hours of 2:00am and 11:00am on Sunday

Q: How long do my patrons have to finish their alcoholic drinks after last call?

A: All alcohol beverages will be consumed or removed no later than 30 minutes after legal sales have been terminated.

### Sec.6-116 Tasting Event at Retail Package Stores

Q: Are multiple tasting event at retail package stores permissible?

A: Yes, retail package stores licensed within the City of Kennesaw shall be authorized to conduct up to 52 tasting events per calendar year. However, they are required to notice the Business License office prior to each event.
