- I. **Call to Order:** Dave Peeples called the meeting to order at 6:31pm
- II. **Approval of Minutes:** KCAC January 27, 2020 minutes. Jacque Cullins moved to accept as presented, Carlene Fregeolle seconded, the motion carried. Minutes approved.
- III. **New Business:**
  - A. The Committee discussed the merger of the Kennesaw Citizen's Advisory Board and Keep Kennesaw Beautiful. The committee reviewed the bylaws of each committee and discussed how the two committees will work together.
  - B. Motion was made by Antonio Jones to accept the bylaws of Kennesaw Citizens Advisory Committee and Keep Kennesaw Beautiful as presented by Bylaws Committee established by the Chair Dave Peeples. Carlene Fregeolle seconded the motion carried.
  - C. Chair Dave Peeples discussed with the committee if it was needed for the committee to meet every month but rather meet when important issues were brought up by the chair or the mayor and council. Aaron Budsock felt that the committee should meet every month because if it did not the membership of the committee would decrease. It was also discussed to have the meeting date of the committees to have flexibility and allow it to change from time to time. Antonio stated that he felt the meeting should stay the same as it is now where the committee meets the 4<sup>th</sup> Thursday of the month to ensure that the committee does not fall by the wayside. He also felt that by having the meeting time change by the month makes it harder for the people on the committee to work it into their schedules.
  - D. Motion was made by Antonio to keep the committee meeting on the 4<sup>th</sup> Thursday of the month except on the months in November when the committee meets at a different

location due to another city board using the mayor and council chambers and also for the month of December when the KCAC host it annual Christmas party. The Chair can also cancel the meeting per state law when he or she feels that the committee has no business to discuss. Carlene Fregeolle Seconded, Motion Carried.

- E.** Chair Dave Peeples discussed the possibility of the committee to have its own blog and how it would function. Mr. Peeples stated that people who do not live in the city limits of Kennesaw could say bad things about the city and they may not even live within the city limits. He also felt that it would be hard for the committee to keep up with the day to day operations of the blog to make sure people are not using foul speech upon it.
- F.** Marty Hughes Deputy City Manager gave the committee an update on the list of SPLOST projects the city is working on and could consider for the future.
- G.** Chair Dave Peeples stated that he was given permission by Legacy Park HOA to post information about the committee in their newsletter.
- H.** Trent Trees gave the committee an update on the street clean ups that are going on around the city and the various companies who sponsor the clean ups around the city.
