The Meeting was called to order by Candice Wharton, Chair.

The minutes of the previous meeting were approved. Motion by Carlene Fregeolle and seconded by Bill Maxson.

The Chair, C. Wharton, reported that two residents have shown interest in joining KICAC. Will invite them to attend next month's meeting.

The Chair asked of those that terms are expiring if they are renewing. To date, two have said yes and four undecided. This prompted a discussion of why were some undecided. Information shared included: dedicated time, value of time, questioned if this committee is making a difference, value of opinion or work by the mayor and city council, possible restructure of committee makeup to be more in line with all other committees whose members are appointed by a council member, discussed increased presence at city council meetings by KCAC members, discussed KCAC be the host for townhalls on pertinent topics that effect or are in progress in the city, discussed the creation of a flier that can be handed out at city hosted trainings ie., City 101 and Citizen Police Academy, discussed creating an annual calendar before January of speakers and programs hosted each month, quote that KCAC needs a "formal connection" to the Mayor and City Council and other committees.

Motion was made by Glenn Dawkins to send a letter from KCAC to Mayor Easterling suggesting a quarterly meeting of city council and all the chairs of the city committees to share information and increase engagement and communication. It was seconded by Bill Maxson. The motion carried. The Chair, Candice Wharton, will draft a letter and send to all members for review before sending.
