RESCINSION OF EXECUTIVE ORDER 02

WHEREAS, the novel coronavirus (COVID-19) has been recognized globally as a contagious respiratory virus; and

WHEREAS, As a result of the continued impact of the COVID-19 pandemic, the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services renewed the January 31, 2020 determination that a public health emergency has existed since January 27, 2020, nationwide.


WHEREAS, on 26 November 2021, the World Health Organization designated the variant B.1.1.529 a variant of concern, named Omicron. As such, communities are asked to continue to implement the effective public health measures to reduce COVID-19 circulation overall; and

WHEREAS, a Declaration of Emergency was executed by the Mayor of the City of Kennesaw and became effective on December 28, 2021 and was further extend on January 28, 2022; and

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the Declaration of Emergency and the Kennesaw Code of Ordinances, Sec. 34-2, it is hereby ORDERED:

1. Effective immediately, in an effort to restore and resume City business, all land use matters requiring a public hearing, including, but not limited to, all zoning, annexation, variance, special land use, historic preservation, and other land use matters, City of Kennesaw Executive Order 01 is rescinded in effect.
