Welcome to the 21st annual Pigs & Peaches BBQ Festival. We are thrilled to have you join us!

COMPETITION:

Anything Butt Information: This year's anything butt meat is **ANDOUILLE SAUSAGE**. You will receive two packages at The Cook's Meeting. You may add any ingredient (s) to create a dish such as stew, main course, or side dish. KCBS garnish and sauce rules do not apply. You may turn in your entry in your Styrofoam container or can be turned in on a cafeteria style tray or a ½ pan. Make sure your number from your Styrofoam container placed on the tray or pan if you use them instead of the provided Styrofoam box. Again, don't use anything that tips over easily to put your food in.

TURN IN TIME IS 7:00 PM FRIDAY NIGHT.

KCBS Competition Meat Turn In: All meats will be turned in in 9x9x3 non divided Styrofoam containers. Make sure your number is on your box.

Peach Dessert Information: This year, there are no special requirements for presentation for the peach dessert, except we ask that you do not use stemmed glasses OR easily tipping containers. Remember your food is judged on taste texture and appearance of the dessert, not the container.

TURN IN TIME 7:30 PM FRIDAY NIGHT.

KCBS Turn-In Times for Saturday:

Ribs 12:30 PM

Pork 1:00 PM

Beef brisket 1:30 PM

The allowable turn-in time will be 5 minutes before and 5 minutes after the posted times with no exceptions. The turn-in location will be inside the west door of the community center.

Our meat inspectors will be on site starting at 9:00 AM Friday morning. They will drive around to your space- you do not have to go to another location. You will need to get your meat inspected before you begin to prepare.

KCBS Competition Meat Turn In: All meats will be turned in in 9x9x3 non divided Styrofoam containers. Make sure your number is on your box.

All contest winner will be required to complete and submit a W-9 for receipt of the cash prize (we will have them on site to fill out). Failure to submit a complete form will result in the forfeiture of the prize.

Handcrafted artisan trophies will be awarded.

The Grand Champion in the professional contest will have their (primary) entry fee waived for the 2020 contest.

Award presentation will take place Saturday, Aug. 22nd at 4:00 pm on the Main Stage. Immediately following the awards ceremony, those who won will meet inside the Community Center to fill out paperwork and receive their prize money.

Unclaimed awards will be held for two weeks at the City of Kennesaw, Parks and Recreation Department's administrative office. After two weeks, the awards will be forfeited.

TEAM LOCATIONS:

Backyard teams are given a 10x20 footprint and pro teams are given a 20x27 footprint unless you chose to upgrade to a larger space in your application or an additional fee. **NO UPGRADES WILL BE GIVEN ONSITE.** Your designated space will be marked on the pavement and all of your equipment must remain inside the lines. Please be kind and flexible to others next to you.

After load in please park your vehicles on Park Drive in the allocated parking spaces. Each team is allowed 1 parking space (located on Park Drive). Additional vehicles must park offsite at nearby locations Swift Cantrell Park, Kennesaw Elementary or Kennesaw First Baptist Church. Please display your parking passes on dashboard. Vehicles without passes may be towed at the owner's expense.

Remember NO TRUCKS OR VEHICLES ARE ALLOWED WITHIN YOUR COOKING SITE. ALSO NO GOLF CARTS OR OTHER MOTORIZED VEHICLES WILL BE ALLOWED ON THE FESTIVAL GROUNDS. You must walk to the turn in door. GIVE YOURSELF ENOUGH TIME TO MAKE IT INSIDE THE TURN IN DOOR WITH YOUR ENTRY.

POWER:

All cook teams will be supplied with a 20 amp electrical connection unless you upgraded to a 30 or 50 amp connection on your application for an additional fee. No upgrades will be granted on site. Electrical connections will not be guaranteed until Friday, August 19th at 4:00 PM. Teams may use their silent generators during the interim period. Electricity will not be supplied after 12:00 midnight on Saturday night.

ICE:

Ice will be available for purchase just outside the Pottery Studio and the Community Center. The ice vendor will contact you to arrange pickup/delivery.

LOAD IN:

When you arrive, please check in at the front desk of the community center. This is where you will receive your parking pass.

Load-in Times:

Thursday, August 18th from 12:00 PM- 7:00 PM

Friday, August 19th from 8:00 AM- 12:00 Noon

ALL COOK TEAMS MUST ARRIVE BY 12:00 NOON FRIDAY. Anyone who arrives after 12:00 Noon will not be able to participate. GPS Address for Adams Park, 2600 Park Drive, Kennesaw, GA 30144

DEPARTURE:

Due to heavy pedestrian traffic and safety issues, vehicles cannot leave the cooking areas during festival hours. This is strictly enforced.

VENDING:

Only cook teams that have paid the additional fee to vend to the public from their cooking space will be allowed to do so. You may not give away food to the public- vendors have paid to be able to sell food and we will not allow others to give away food or beverages away for free.

DISPOSAL:

Ash, gray water, grease and trash must be properly discarded in containers located in the cooking areas. Failure to comply may result in a fine or disqualification.

RESTROOMS:

You may use the permanent restrooms near the tennis courts, ball fields or inside the Community Center or the Recreation Center. There will also be portable facilities located in the main festival grounds with hand washing facilities.

SECURITY:

Police and park staff will patrol cooking areas through the event and overnight on Friday. However, the City of Kennesaw will not assume any responsibility for loss, damage, or theft of any kind, whether it be by fire, physical violence, or acts of nature.

COOK'S MEETING:

All cook teams must have one representative at the meeting held Friday, August 19th at 4:00 PM in the Banquet Hall of the Community Center. You will have a chance to ask questions and discuss turn-in times, and rules. You will also meet Doug Rhodes, the judging coordinator and Julie and Rusty Cook, the KCBS representatives.

At the meeting, please pick up your team bag that will include:

- 1 Complementary T-Shirt
- 1 Complementary Commemorative Pin
- Additional T-shirts purchased with registration

Pick up your bacon for the Anything Butt competition

Pick up your Styrofoam containers for turn-in.

HOSPITALITY ROOM:

Cook teams will have access to the hospitality room inside the community center on Friday, August 19th from 5:00 PM - 9:00 PM and Saturday, August 20th from 7:00 AM - 9:00 PM. This will offer a comfortable place to relax, cool off and enjoy light refreshments.
